Call to Order: Edmondson at 7:13 pm

A quorum was present.

This was an informational meeting for residents and followed the topics and speakers of the Agenda, although the order sometimes differed with the agenda as submitted by Edmondson.

METRO CEO George Greanias spoke to the group for several minutes. In addition to how METRO has changed for the better over the past fourteen months, he also remembered with fondness his days as our City Council representative in decades past. Next to speak was our term limited City Council Member Anne Clutterbuck. Edmondson praised her for all she has done for Westbury. Anne was momentarily speechless when she learned that the fruit tree orchard at the community garden will be named Anne's Orchard in her name.

Several representatives for candidates for the November City and other local elections were present. Noteworthy were the repeat visits, in person, by Larry Green and Wendell Robbins.

Usually, there are no votes at this meeting, but tonight there were two items requiring a vote. (1) Approved was a resolution from the Civic Club that the Harris County Flood Control District continue with Project Brays through to its completion at a rate of \$20 million per year and that the Federal share be reimbursed to the District. (2) Bylaws revisions were adopted.

A vote was not needed on the new officers as per bylaws, members self nominated by a given date and there were no competitive races. Therefore the slate becomes our new officers. These will appear in next CRIER. Several vacancies remained and it was heartening to see several interested audience members who wanted to talk with Edmondson after the meeting.
